General APA Guidelines. Your essay should be typed and double-spaced on standard-sized paper (8.5" x 11"), with 1" margins on all sides. Include a page header (also known as the "running head") at the top of every page. For a professional paper, this includes your paper title and the page number.

### APA Style

Align the text of an APA Style paper to the left margin. Leave the right margin uneven, or "ragged." Do not use full justification for student papers or manuscripts being submitted for publication. Do not insert hyphens (manual breaks) in words at the end of line.

### Paragraph Alignment and Indentation - APA Style

Format. Example. Paper title. Place the title three to four lines down from the top of the title page. Center it and type it in bold font. Capitalize major words of the title. Place the main title and any subtitle on separate double-spaced lines if desired. There is no maximum length for titles; however, keep titles focused and include key terms.

### Title Page Setup - APA Style

Although published articles differ in format from manuscripts submitted for publication or student papers (e.g., different line spacing, font, margins, and column format), articles published in APA journals provide excellent demonstrations of APA Style in action. APA journals will begin publishing papers in seventh edition APA Style in 2020.

### Sample Papers - American Psychological Association

The sixth edition provides explicit rules for direct quotations and states that you must credit the source when "paraphrasing, quoting an author directly, or describing an idea that influenced your work" (p. 170). If the

quotation is less than 40 words, incorporate the quotation into the text and place quotation marks round the quotation.

### **APA Changes 6th Edition // Purdue Writing Lab**

APA style calls for capitalizing important words in titles when they are written in the text (but not when they are written in reference lists). A similar study was done of students learning to format research papers ("Using Citations," 2001).

### **In-Text Citations: Author/Authors // Purdue Writing Lab**

Follow these guidelines to include page numbers in both student and professional APA Style papers: Use the page-numbering function of your word-processing program to insert page numbers. Insert page numbers in the top right corner. The page number should show on all pages.

### **Formatting Your Student Paper - APA 7th ed. - Research ...**

Such notations are called in-text citations, and APA format dictates that when citing in APA format in the text of your paper, use the author's name followed by the date of publication. For example, if you were to cite Sigmund Freud's book *The Interpretation of Dreams*, you would use the following format: (Freud, 1900).

### **APA Format: Basic Rules You Must Follow**

An APA in-text citation includes only three items: the last name (s) of the author (s), the year the source was published, and sometimes the page or location of the information. References include more information such as the name of the author (s), the year the source was published, the full title of the source, and the URL or page range.
